All Pretrial Progress Reports filed by any Pretrial Services Officer shall be immediately impounded upon the filing of said Report by the Circuit Clerk of each county in the Twenty-Fourth Judicial Circuit. Per Rule 4-3(a)(2) of the Rules of Practice of the Circuit Court of Illinois in the Twenty-Fourth Judicial Circuit, "Impounded" means "[a] file or document which is accessible only to the attorney of record or the parties of record on a case; otherwise, the file or document is only accessible upon order of court." The Circuit Clerk's Office shall provide the defendant's attorney, or the defendant if unrepresented, with any Pretrial Progress Report upon the filing of such report.
